


COMMUNITY UPDATE

SITE ACTIVITY UPDATE

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



- Multiplex continue to make progress with digging for the London Underground Integrated Ticket Hall
- Concrete core for the UAL building is now at the second storey
- Concrete core for the 34 storey residential tower building is now up to ground floor level
- Tower cranes have been successfully installed during the last period
- Tower Crane 6 is due to be erected in the last quarter of 2023 (Oct-Dec)
- There are currently four gates in use across the project and they are managed by teams of dedicated, trained traffic marshals

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY UPDATE

WASTE MANAGEMENT

100% of non-hazardous construction waste has been diverted from landfill. The waste has been either reused offsite or processed for energy recovery. This is above the project target of 99%.

AIR QUALITY

As of March 2023, the project team has embarked on an air quality footprint pilot scheme. In partnership with Ricardo, the Elephant & Castle Town Centre Re-development is being used as a study project to help the industry better understand its impact on local air quality.

BIODIVERSITY VOLUNTEERING

On Tuesday 15th March 2023 a Multiplex Team completed a biodiversity volunteering day in Southwark at the Peckham Rye Park. This marked the beginning of a year long restoration project being undertaken in partnership with RSPB, the UK's largest nature conservation charity.
