

 The E1 (12 storey new LCC campus building) concrete structure is complete, and façade installation has progressed up to level 10 to all elevations. All eleven sets

3. New UAL: LCC Campus Building: All eleven sets of the feature stairs installed

- of the atrium feature stairs have been installed with final decorations now taking place and painting ongoing. In addition, the building maintenance unit has now been installed on level 12 and is currently being commissioned.
- The tower 1 (34 storey residential tower) concrete structure is now complete. The
 precast façade has progressed up to level 20, whilst bathroom pods have now
 been loaded out to level 31. Works on ventilation and installing key cables has also
 progressed up to level 32. Internal apartment walls are also now progressing in
 sequence.
- The tower 2 (20 storey residential tower) and tower 3 (22 storey residential tower)
 concrete structures are now complete. Façade panel installation on the residential
 areas is complete on tower 2 and has progressed up to to level 21 on tower 3. The
 bathroom pod load out has now completed on both towers, whilst fit out works
 continue to progress in sequence internally.
- There are currently three vehicle entry/exit gates and two external pit lanes in use across the project, managed by teams of dedicated trained traffic marshals through Multiplex's supply chain partner, Clipfine. One tower crane was recently removed from the project.
- At present, approximately 980 people working on the project every day, encompassing operatives (approximately 780) and management staff (approximately 200).

The Multiplex team has recently facilitated an additional work experience student. Whilst on site, the student spent time with the construction and finance teams and gained an understanding of project management and the commercial aspects of construction.

Multiplex continues to work with its supply chain teams to secure new employment opportunities. Multiplex is presently undertaking an exercise to identify employment opportunities which will soon become available, and will then advertise these through its local networks.

The Multiplex team continues to organise its charity golf tournament, scheduled for Tuesday 8th October. All proceeds will go directly towards the project's chosen charity, Chickenshed.
